

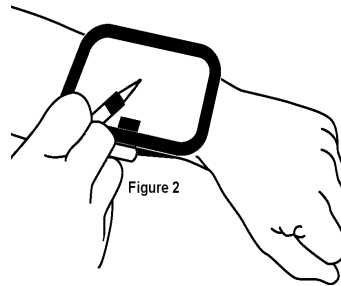
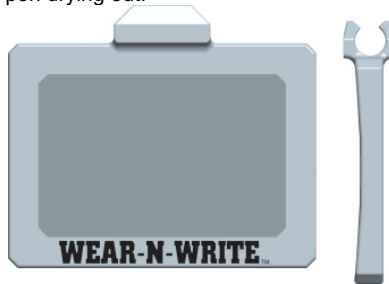

Use, Care & Assembly Instructions for Model #948946

Wristband Wear-N-Write Dry Erase Memorandum Notepad.

Not a toy for children. Allow use only under strict supervision.

1. **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT ONLY THE DRY ERASE MARKER PROVIDED IN THIS PACKAGE BE USED FOR THIS PRODUCT.**
2. **INK APPLIED DIRECTLY FROM THE DRY ERASE MARKER PROVIDED IN THIS PACKAGE MAY STAIN CLOTHING OR OTHER SURFACES. ONCE THE INK DRIES ON WRITING TABLET IT TYPICALLY DOES NOT STAIN CLOTHING. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE INK BE ALLOWED TO DRY (approx. 7 seconds) BEFORE ALLOWING THE WRITING TABLET TO COME IN CONTACT WITH CLOTHING OR OTHER SURFACES.**
3. **HELPFUL TIP:** In case the dried ink on the writing tablet comes in *ACCIDENTAL CONTACT* with clothing and leaves a mark, the dried ink residue or "dust" can be brushed away with a clean cloth. If unsuccessful, immediately wash affected area with clean water and pat dry with clean cloth to remove the dried ink residue.
4. **Erase or wipe the writing pallet clean after each use.** Dry erase ink left on the writing pallet too long may be more difficult to remove and may require a damp or soft towel to wipe clean.
5. Store in a dry place. Replace cap on pen securely and immediately after each use to avoid pen drying out.



Pen attachment.

- Step 1.** Press pen into molded Slot on top of writing pad.
Gently pull outward to remove.

Wrist Application

- Step 1.** Place Wear-N-Write with pallet facing up on wrist. Fig. 2
- Step 2.** Join ends of elastic band together under wrist and secure with Velcro.
- Step 3.** Adjust fit for comfort. **FIT SHOULD BE SNUG BUT DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN! LOOSEN FIT IF DISCOMFORT OCCURS**

Optional Clip

- Step 1.** Remove the elastic wristband by sliding it out of back.
- Step 2.** Slip the end with the two slots into the vertical opening on reverse.
- Step 3.** Attach to desired object.

CAUTION: Never use the Wear-N-Write products while driving or in any way that would distract you from operating machinery or operating in a safe manner. Never use Wear-N-Write near moving parts or machinery that may become entangled and cause injury to the user.
